Transportation Alternative (TA) grant program through the city of Bismarck in the amount of \$172,950 to support this project. The project is scheduled for construction in 2020. As in the past, the Park District is being asked to approve the enclosed Companion Agreement. It is an agreement between the city of Bismarck and the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District requiring the Park District to undertake all of the duties and responsibilities contained in the agreement between the city of Bismarck and the North Dakota Department of Transportation. This agreement references the NDDOT agreement (the second one) as an attachment. The Park District only needs to approve and sign the first agreement as the second one is an attachment. This is standard procedure for TA grant projects.
